The Chicago Police Department is in receipt of your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for the following:

Requesting all records pertaining to / related to "No Games Chicago"

The enclosed documents are responsive to this request.

Section 7(1)(c) exempts from disclosure :[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." The responsive documents provide the identities of individuals and organizations of individuals who were the potential subjects of investigations but were not charged with criminal offenses.

The FOIA prohibits the CPD from releasing the documents entitled "Verbal Authorization" and "First Amendment Intelligence Gathering Investigation" related pre decisional events". The FOIA states "preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated shall be exempt from disclosure." FOIA 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f). The reports contain preliminary opinions or notes of supervisory staff made before the "No Games" investigation was completed. These documents are therefore exempt from disclosure.

Finally, Private information (employee identification numbers, user identification numbers, dates of birth, home or personal telephone numbers, signatures and other unique identifiers) are exempt and have been redacted from the attached documents. The redacted information is exempt from disclosure under the following provisions of the Freedom of Information Act:

 $5ILCS\ 140/7(b)$ Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or Federal Law or a Court Order.



The the past, the International Olympic Committee and the actual Olympic Cames have been the target of unlawful acts such as disorderly conduct, criminal trespass and criminal damage to property. Recently, protests against the apcoming 2010 Olympics in Vancouver British Columbia resulted in several arrests. The purpose of this layestigation is to determine if groups or individuals are planning or will plan unlawful acts directed at the International Olympic Committee during their Chicago visit.

Among the investigative techniques that may be utilized are the monitoring of websites, collection of pamphlets, trash covers and the use of undercover officers to attend public meetings. Groups and individuals are becoming increasingly fiesitant to post detailed information on websites due to the fact that they may be monitored by law enforcement. It is for this reason that unlawful acts.

General Counsel. This investigation is not expected to continue beyond thirty (30) days, barring the discovery of intelligence that would warrant an extension request.


